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This week's health care reform news:

Health Reform Implementation, Political Fighting Continue

Two important sets of Affordable Care Act (ACA) regulations were released last week—impacting wellness programs and SHOP exchanges—even as news reports indicate that a new public relations battle over the ACA is just getting underway.

Other highlights include:

- California has adopted new performance standards for qualified health plans and made no changes to a 4.4% assessment on premiums.
- A Connecticut bill would require the state's exchange to negotiate premiums with qualified health plans.
- New Hampshire's state senators are balking at expanding Medicaid coverage as the governor supports doing.

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
